New openings add to the city's ever-growing list of terraces for a drink with a view

Featuring stunning vistas, signature cocktails and chill-out vibes, the city's hotels open up their top floors to anyone looking to make the most of a relaxing summer evening – whether you are looking for a 'Sunset Party', want to cool off in an infinity pool (or a open air Jacuzzi!), have a late drink at 2am or simply chill out in an intimate rooftop garden.

Deck 7, Porto Bay Liberdade NEW FOR 2015

Deck 7 is the rooftop lounge bar that crowns Porto Bay Liberdade, the latest five-star hotel to open in Lisbon (February 2015). Located close to Avenida da Liberdade, the city's premier shopping destination and home to some of the world's most prestigious luxury brands, you can take in the views as you enjoy your drink on the wooden deck – or from the rooftop Jacuzzi!

Limão, H10 Duque de Loulé NEW FOR 2015

Limão, its 'chill-out terrace', is located on the hotel's tenth floor, combining an elegant open-air space with stunning views across the city and the Tagus Estuary, especially at sunset.
