Hotel group's 'Cycling Package' invites guests to tour like Team Sky

The 'Cycling Package' combines an idyllic hotel stay and many guest benefits, including a fourday carbon fibre bike rental for cyclists to discover the most beautiful corners of the largest island in the Canaries on two wheels, plus a spa massage to revitalise cyclists' weary muscles. All inclusions are as follows:

- Seven nights' accommodation on a half board basis with daily buffet breakfast and dinner
- Welcome drink of sparkling wine
- Rental of a carbon fibre street bike for 4 days (helmet included)
- A 60-minute relaxing massage or a 25-minute post-training massage (depending on the hotel) and complimentary spa access

A popular destination for sporting fans, Tenerife boasts a year-round warm climate and a variety of landscapes that guarantee an amazing cycling experience for visitors. As well as the demanding cycle routes available at Teide National Park, with its high altitude favoured by Team Sky, the island offers a wide network of mountain biking trails through volcanic territories, lush valleys and pristine pine tree forests.

Prices for a seven-night 'Cycling Package' for two people start from €1,785 (approximately £1,311) at 5\* Hotel Jardines de Nivaria; from €1,372 (£1,008) at 5\* Roca Nivaria Gran Hotel; and from €1,050 (£772) at 4\* Hotel Colón Guanahaní.

# 5\* Hotel Jardines de Nivaria

The five-star Hotel Jardines de Nivaria sits right next to the beach in the exclusive Playa Fañabé area of Costa Adeje. The hotel, considered one of the most luxurious in south Tenerife, combines an elegant mixture of Art-deco and Spanish traditional style enhanced by the dome that crowns the main building and represents the stars and constellations visible from the hotel during the spring equinox. The beachfront hotel offers 271 stylish rooms; chic bars and gourmet dining; a luxury spa with beauty treatments; two lagoon pools; a fully-equipped gym; and a beautiful garden with palm trees.

## 5\* Roca Nivaria Gran Hotel

A self-contained oasis of calm and tranquillity, Roca Nivaria Gran Hotel is the latest addition to the Adrián Hoteles portfolio. Located in the peaceful Playa Paraíso area on the southern coast of Costa Adeje, the five-star hotel features a total of 289 rooms with private terrace, an infinity pool with Balinese chill-out beds and sea views, open-air Jacuzzi and rooftop sun terrace, four restaurants and bars, and a 'mini club' for children between 10 months and 12 years old. Sports facilities include two tennis courts, a gym, archery range, beach volleyball court and sports centre.

#### 4\* Hotel Colón Guanahaní

Hotel Colón Guanahaní is a charming adults-only hotel located just 150m from the sandy beaches of Playa Fañabé. The four-star boutique reopened in late 2014 following a €3.5 million refurbishment and features 154 colonial-style rooms and a range of first class facilities, including a fully-equipped gymnasium; two restaurants renowned for their excellent cuisine; a wellness centre featuring a Turkish bath, Jacuzzi and sauna; two saltwater swimming pools; Balinese beds overlooking the Atlantic Ocean; and a rooftop pool with sea views and a solarium for soaking up the rays.
