

ALL THREE ADRIÁN HOTELES' PROPERTIES IN TENERIFE RANKED IN TRIPADVISOR'S TOP TEN MOST SUSTAINABLE HOTELS IN SPAIN

Hotel Jardines de Nivaria holds first position, Hotel Colón Guanahani third and Roca Nivaria Gran Hotel ninth place in the ranking



13th October 2015 – All three properties of Tenerife's family-run group, Adrián Hoteles, have made it into the top 10 of Spain's most sustainable hotels, voted by users of popular rating site TripAdvisor. The 5* [Hotel Jardines de Nivaria](#) leads the ranking, voted the best hotel for sustainability, while 4* [Hotel Colón Guanahani](#) and 5* [Roca Nivaria Gran Hotel](#) hold the third and ninth positions respectively. The three Adrián Hoteles properties are the only hotels in the Canary Islands that have made it into TripAdvisor's eco ranking.

Rafael Adrián, owner of Adrián Hoteles, comments on this recognition: *"We are delighted that our three hotels are in the top 10 of the best environmentally-friendly properties in Spain –two of them making the top 3. This accolade is especially important for us as votes come directly from customers – it always feels gratifying to be awarded by them."*

The eco-survey is judged by taking into account both the quality and quantity of the ratings from the users of TripAdvisor. Those that achieve the highest ratings receive Platinum Level status within the site's Green Leaders programme, created to recognise those hotels which are committed to green practices.

This latest accolade follows earlier recognition for Adrián Hoteles in sustainability, including the 'Travelife Gold' certificate that ABTA (Association of British Travel Agents) awarded the group's three hotels earlier this year due to their commitment to sustainable tourism. Also, all three properties have the EMAS (the EU Eco-Management and Audit Scheme) and ISO 14001 certifications in place, together with training and education programmes on green practices for both staff and guests.

THE HOTELS

5* Hotel Jardines de Nivaria

The five-star Hotel Jardines de Nivaria sits right next to the beach in the exclusive Playa Fañabé area of Costa Adeje. The hotel, considered one of the most luxurious in south Tenerife, combines an elegant mixture of Art-deco and Spanish traditional style enhanced by the dome that crowns the main building and represents the stars and constellations visible from the hotel during the spring equinox. The beachfront hotel offers 271 stylish rooms; chic bars and gourmet dining; a luxury spa with beauty treatments; two lagoon pools; a fully-equipped gym; and a beautiful garden with palm trees.

5* Roca Nivaria Gran Hotel

A self-contained oasis of calm and tranquillity, Roca Nivaria Gran Hotel is the latest addition to the Adrián Hoteles portfolio. Located in the peaceful Playa Paraíso area on the southern coast of Costa Adeje, the five-star hotel features a total of 289 rooms with private terrace, an infinity pool with Balinese chill-out beds and sea views, open-air Jacuzzi and rooftop sun terrace, four restaurants and bars, and a 'mini club' for children between 10 months and 12 years old. Sports facilities include two tennis courts, a gym, archery range, beach volleyball court and sports centre.

4* Hotel Colón Guanahaní

Hotel Colón Guanahaní is a charming adults-only hotel located just 150m from the sandy beaches of Playa Fañabé. The four-star boutique reopened in late 2014 following a €3.5 million refurbishment and features 154 colonial-style rooms and a range of first class facilities, including a fully-equipped gymnasium; two restaurants renowned for their excellent cuisine; a wellness centre featuring a Turkish bath, Jacuzzi and sauna; two saltwater swimming pools; Balinese beds overlooking the Atlantic Ocean; and a rooftop pool with sea views and a solarium for soaking up the rays.
