

Tenerife's 'Sunset and Stars' becomes a Michelin-starred experience with award-winning Chef Erlantz Gorostiza

Sunset, stargazing and fine dining at Spain's highest peak

- A stargazing session with English-speaking guides and long-range telescopes.

As well as being Europe's most visited national park, the Teide National Park is also considered one of the best locations on the planet for stargazing due to its clear dark skies, low light pollution and high altitude.
