The city will be awash with famous faces including featured artists Beyoncé, Radiohead and Kendrick Lamar. Celebrities and holidaymakers alike will be welcomed to Palm Springs during the festival, which will take place over two weekends in April ($14^{th} - 16^{th} \& 21^{st} - 23^{rd}$).

With 350 days of sunshine and less than five inches of rain a year, visitors to Palm Springs are guaranteed a truly Californian experience. The city offers an endless choice of things to see and do, from hiking in the Indian Canyons and riding the Palm Springs Aerial Tramway, to shopping in independent boutiques and browsing the downtown art district. This, combined with the city's

enduring celebrity appeal, beautiful landscapes and host of fabulous restaurants, bars and cafes offers everyone, young or old, the ultimate holiday experience.
