The main event, which has been dubbed the most important music event in the Canary Islands for the past 30 years, is the final gig of Aerosmith’s farewell tour on 8<sup>th</sup> July.

### **Heineken Canary Islands Jazz Festival**

American vocalist Charenée Wade and Cuban Alfredo Rodríguez Trio will kick off the event on 7<sup>th</sup> July, which will also be hosting English singer Jacob Collier and American musicians Becca Stevens and Cory Henry.
