*AirlinesRating.com used seven safety criteria to assess airlines. Each of the top 10 airlines has:

- 1. Completed an IATA (International Air Transport Association) Operational Safety Audit, i.e. earned IOSA Certification.
- 2. Met the European Union's high standards of aircraft maintenance and regulatory oversight and are not on the EU Blacklist.
- 3. Maintained a fatality-free record for the past 10 years.
- 4. Flown to the United States from a country that upholds the Federal Aviation Authority's (FAA's) aircraft operations and maintenance requirements.
- 5. Originated in a country that fulfils all eight International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) safety parameters.
- 6. Never been grounded by any governing aviation safety authority.
- 7. Built a fleet using Boeing, Airbus and McDonnell Douglas aircraft and does not operate Russian-built aircraft.
