Former home of Hollywood screen siren is now open to the public

Dame Elizabeth Taylor was one of many iconic stars who played and stayed in "Hollywood's playground", many of whom were lured to the Palm Springs desert for the year-round sunshine and relaxing privacy it offered, just two hours from Hollywood studios in LA. Today, visitors to Palm Springs can enjoy many celebrity experiences in the city and return home to share stories of residing in the one-time residences of some of the biggest names of our time, such as Frank Sinatra, Marilyn Monroe and Dean Martin.
